

## . FRIENDS OF ANATOLIA 2006 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

### Program Budget:

<b>Full School Support:</b>	\$20,000 (two challenge gifts and a nonprofit donation)
<b>Follow-Up Grants:</b>	\$1,000 (from matching gifts)
<b>Teacher's Trainings:</b>	\$1,000 (from matching gifts)
<b>Mini Grants:</b>	\$1,500 (from matching gifts)
<b>Teacher's Scholarship:</b>	\$3,000 (from individual donations and matching gifts)
<b>Other School Project Costs:</b>	\$8,500 (from individual donations and matching gifts)
<b>AFL Library Modernization:</b>	\$10,000 (from AFL alumni, individual donations / fiscal sponsorship)
<b>Student's Scholarship:</b>	\$10,000 (from an individual donor / donor advised fund)
<b>Total:</b>	<b>\$55,000</b>

### 2006 Programs:

The educational programs mostly take place in Turkey during the summer. Therefore they require fundraising efforts early in the year. The details of these projects and their funding needs this year are as follows:

- 1- Full School Support:** These include renovation of the school building and providing supplies. Each project costs around \$10,000. This year there are two school support projects planned.
  - Yildiztepe Elementary School in Duzce, Turkey : \$10,000 (Funding is coming from two separate challenge gifts restricted to this project. One of these challenge gifts were set by an individual donor, Yavuz and Sibel Sert, whereas the other came from a private foundation, Turkish Cultural Foundation.)
  - Yunus Emre Elementary School in Sanliurfa, Turkey: \$10,000 (Funding is provided TALL, Turkish American Ladies League, a Turkish-American nonprofit organization in Southern California.)
- 2- Follow-Up Grants:** These include the support for the previous year's full school support projects. Each school will receive \$500 additional funding to take care of the needs that appeared since the last repairs.
  - Dibekduzu Elementary School in Sanliurfa, Turkey: \$500 (Funding is provided from the matching gifts of the challenge gifts that were set for the Yildiztepe Elementary School.)
  - Sarikoy Elementary School in Mardin, Turkey: \$500 (Funding is provided from the matching gifts of the challenge gifts that were set for the Yildiztepe Elementary School.)
- 3-Teachers' Trainings:** "Friends of Anatolia Teacher's Training about Volunteerism" in cooperation with Space Camp Turkey in Izmir. This project aims to offer basic training about volunteerism and help teachers do better needs assessment for their schools so that they can communicate the needs with funders more effectively.
  - Space Camp Turkey in Izmir, Turkey: \$1,000 (Funding is provided by Space Camp Turkey and from the matching gifts of the challenge gifts that were set for the Yildiztepe Elementary School.)
- 4- Mini Grants:** These were awarded to the schools whose teachers participated in "Friends of Anatolia Teacher's Training about Volunteerism" in cooperation with Space Camp Turkey in Izmir.

- i. In Samsun, Turkey: \$500
- ii. In Malatya, Turkey: \$500
- iii. In Uzak, Turkey: \$500

(Funding is provided from the matching gifts of the challenge gifts that were set for the Yildiztepe Elementary School.)

**5- Teacher's Scholarship:** "Young Teachers as Civil Leaders" is a scholarship that is awarded to unemployed young teachers for six months, renewal up to two terms, to help them gain volunteer work experience during their transition to their permanent job as teachers.

Mehmet Okur of Diyarbakir, Turkey: \$3,000

This is a young science teacher who is not assigned to a permanent position yet. He will be receiving \$250/month for 6 months. In return, he will commit 15-20/week as volunteer, coordinating education projects in Turkey.

(Funding is provided from the matching gifts of the challenge gifts that were set for the Yildiztepe Elementary School and other individual donations.)

**6-Other School Project Costs:** The school projects in Turkey require close follow-up, careful execution and other technical equipment such as camera, recorder, video, and a laptop.

- School Project Execution: \$3,000  
The school projects will be coordinated by our teacher scholarship recipient in Turkey. He will receive \$250/month for six months, until the projects are complete, to cover the domestic travel costs, phone and internet bills and printing costs.
- School Project Assets: \$2,500  
The school projects coordinator will need basic technical equipment to provide reliable data. These technical equipment include but are not limited to laptop, printer, camera, video, phone, fax, memory stick, and recorder.
- School Project Evaluations: \$3,000  
The school projects require an external evaluation by one of the Board members from the United States for the due diligence purposes. This amount is budgeted for the travel expenses of that person.

**7-AFL Library Modernization:** This is a fiscal sponsorship project led by Ankara Science High School Alumni (AFL). The purpose is to raise funds to renovate the school library. Friends of Anatolia helps this group by sharing its tax-exempt status and insurance. It also takes care of the administrative burden of this project. In return, Friends of Anatolia gets 10 percent from the total donations to cover the administrative costs, and it reserves 5 percent for the future AFL projects.

- AFL Library: \$10,000 (Funding is provided from the individual contributions of AFL alumni in form of fiscal sponsorship.)

**8-Student Scholarship:** Mehmet Okur Donor Advised Scholarship Fund is set by an individual donor, a well-known NBA player. This is a donor advised fund and it will benefit one needy Ph.D. student based on academic merit. The recipient is chosen by the donor and the continuation of this scholarship will be decided later.

- Suleyman Ari of UCLA, California: \$10,000

This young man is a successful blind Ph.D. student studying at UCLA, California. He will be receiving \$2,500/quarter for one year. However, the recipient felt the need to take a leave of absence due to health problems. Therefore, the scholarship is currently on hold until September 2006.

(Funding is provided by an individual donor in form of a donor advised fund.)
